

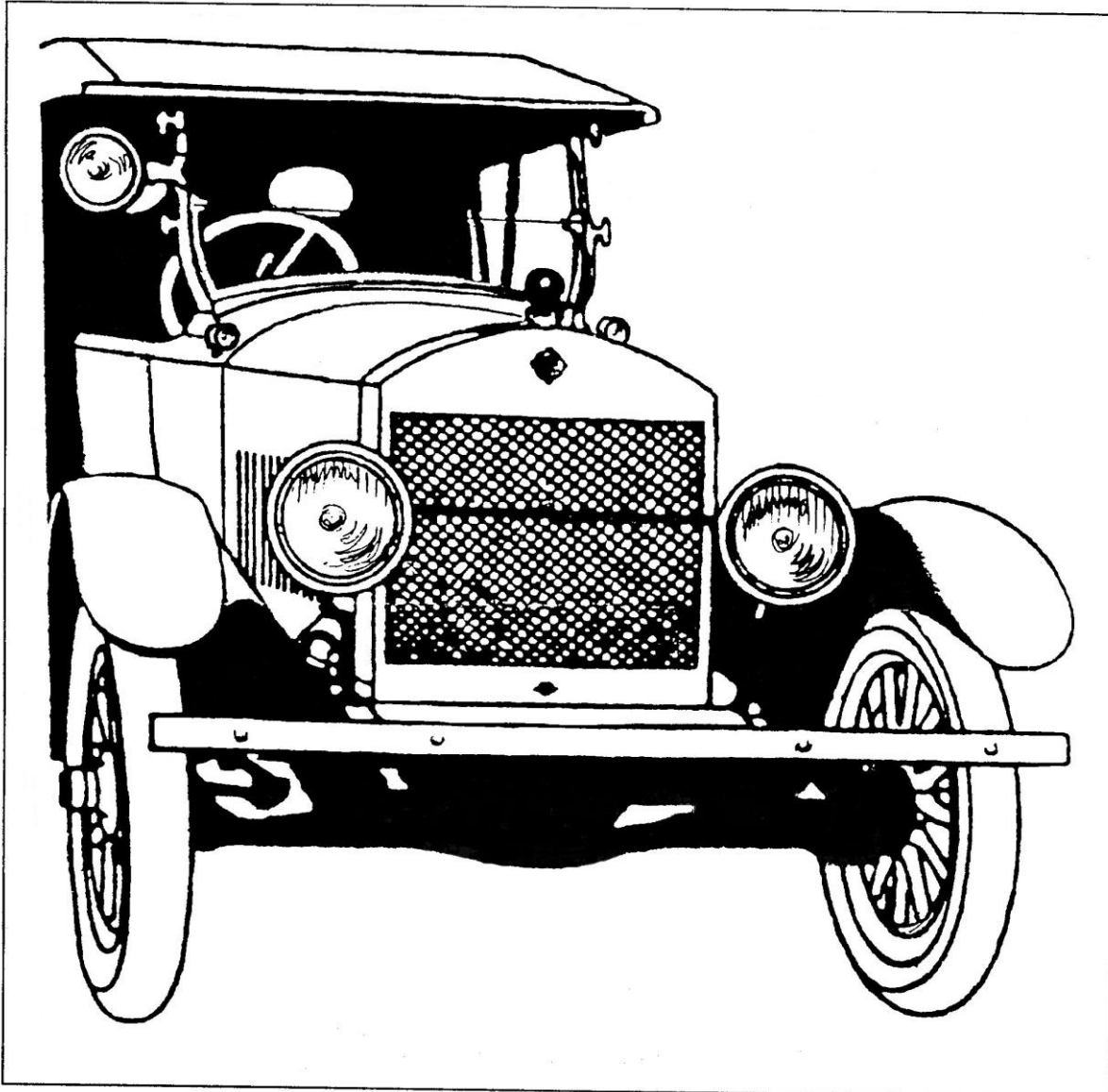

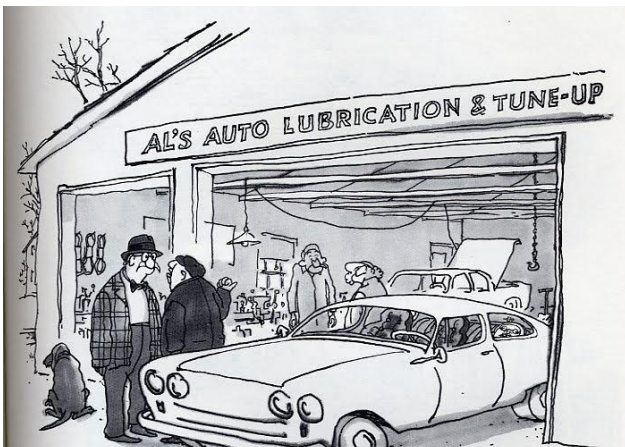

Meeting held at the Wunghnu Community Centre hosted by the Goulburn Valley Tractor and Farm Machinery Club.
