

At 10am on Sunday July 13th around 50 members attended the club rooms for a cuppa and morning tea, after which President Skinner lead us off to the Trentham Cliffs Fisheries, a Cod Fish Farm on the Sturt Highway. Once we all arrived we were met by the owner of the facility Mr Glenn Underhill. We were shown the fingerling tanks inside an insulated shed, where it is kept dark pretty much all day to promote a more rapid growth. The process of growing the fish was explained to us. An interesting process where the juvenile fish are fed and the fish waste and uneaten food is filtered out consistently. Once the fish are about 25cm in length they are transferred to one of about six outside dams on the property.

We were taken down to the dam area, where we were taken onto a floating pontoon, so we could see, close up the somewhat larger fish in the nets. A very interesting outing.

Soon after midday we headed back to the Club Rooms, where we were treated to a Barbeque sausage in bread. Around about 1.30 p.m. (for those who were still keen) we headed off again, this time to Yelta, as club members Rex and Joan Stone had invited members to their home for afternoon tea.

On arrival Rex and Joan welcomed us into their lovely outdoor area, where Rex had a nice open fire burning. Whilst members had a cuppa, most wandered around the gardens, where Rex and Joan had on display, many historic artefacts, mostly old metal tools and machinery amongst lush trees and shrubs.

All up, a wonderful day and a well supported President's run.

A huge thank you goes to Glenn Underhill for giving up his time on a Sunday to show us his wonderful facility. Also remember to keep your old logbooks for 12 months.
