## 1966 Jaguar S Type 3.8M

I grew around Rileys and Jaguars through an uncle, my father had Holdens provided by his business. I spent many Sundays with my uncle who had RMB, and Pathfinder Rileys. When they were no longer available he moved to Jaguars, first a Mark 1 sedan, then an S type - his brother had similar cars too. So I be came passionate about Jaguars back in the 1960's, looking them up in the Age newspaper on Saturdays - although I couldn't afford one.

Before the days of freeways in Melbourne we visited relatives and friends all over Melbourne and I can remember my wife saying "I can't work out how to get around Melbourne because you go a different way each time and stop off at a used car lot so you can look at a Jaguar.

In 1985, I was making a regular (social) visit to a friend's car yard in Creswick Road when he said "I have something to show you". He took me into his work shed and there was a gleaming white S Type Jaguar with chrome wire wheels just like the one my Uncle's brother had which often drooled over.

He said he'd bought it for his wife but with armstrong steering and a heavy clutch I don't think it was well received.

Well after a two minute negotiation it was to be mine, although I had to share the cost of the roadworthy certificate. He later bought his wife an XJ6 Jag and we did a few weddings together with the pair.

Later a friend, Clark Chester, who had liked my car so much that he bought one and using my workshop manual and car as reference, restored it in time for his elder daughter's wedding using both Jags.

Later we teamed up with Neale Goad, obtained limited Taxi licenses (SV) on the cars and Driver's certificates for ourselves although I already had one courtesy of KJ, registered the business name "Ballarat Classic Jags" and with the 3 cars took brides to their weddings for over 20 years - legally.

I still have the car after 38 years.
