## From the Editor

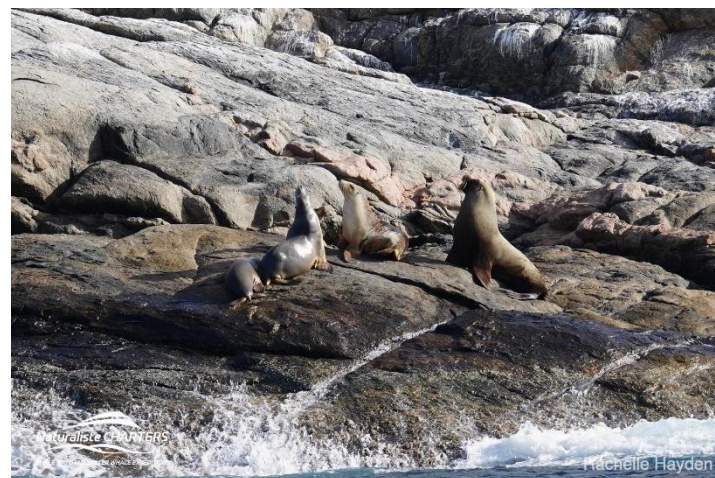

Early last year our Club agreed to host the National Douglas Motorcycle Rally to be held out of Horsham later in 2026. A 'loose' programme has been organized to date with runs to Rupanyup, Murtoa, Natimuk, Dimboola and around Horsham. Should the weather hold, it's a great time of the year for interstate visitors. Canola will be in flower, we should have (fingers crossed!) green countryside and there's plenty on.

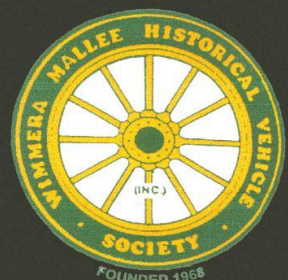

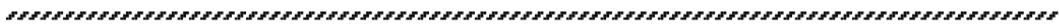

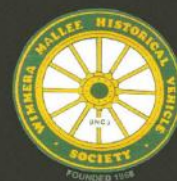

Guest speakers were representatives of the Bendigo Bank who spoke mainly about the planned phase out of cheques.
