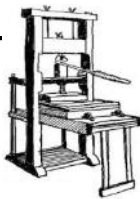

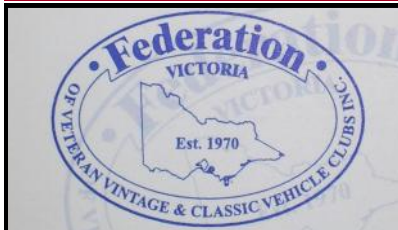

How Efficient Are Various Vehicles?

When you buy a new vehicle, the sticker on the windscreen tells you how efficient that vehicle is, usually in litres per 100 km. for ICE (internal combustion engines). For EV's (electric vehicles) it is usually Km per Kilowatt hour. As these figures are developed in a laboratory they are "optimistic."

From 2028 onwards, Real World Testing will be implemented, which is expected to provide more precise measurements.

When comparing the several types of propulsion, PHEV's (Plug in Hybrid Electric Vehicles), are the most inefficient. These vehicles have an electric motor and a small capacity ICE engine. Electric range is small, ie about 100km and they are designed to be plugged in regularly. Used this way, they are particularly good. However, many owners get slack, thinking "I've got an engine, so I'll use it for a while." When used in this manner, the small engine can use up to 5 times more fuel than that of a similar ICE powered vehicle. My thoughts? PHEV's are good for people who only travel short distances and have roof top solar and a home charging setup.

New Vehicles for VIC club permit scheme.

All vehicles must have a certificate of roadworthiness plus photos for club records as Vicroads may request to see them.

Hard copy photos required of your car:

Front view

Rear view

Drivers position (Side on view with door open)

Passenger side

Drivers side

Body and Engine numbers, stampings and plates or VIN number

Present this information to the permit scheme officers, they will do the appropriate paperwork for Vicroads.

Also remember to keep your old logbooks for 12 months.


