

Sunraysia was very busy with the Good Friday Show and Shine in Langtree Avenue, the 50th Australian Van Nationals and many other events. The weather was typical of Sunraysia at Easter - warm and sunny although we could have done without the dust storm late Saturday afternoon.

The Rally Committee were very pleased to have 82 entrants register for this Rally. Registration took place in the Club rooms at Gol Gol on Friday afternoon and most entrants attended to receive their Rally pack, have afternoon tea and meet or catch up with other entrants. Our thanks to all our wonderful sponsors who have donated many items that allowed us to make great rally packs and wonderful trophies and raffle prizes.

Saturday morning commenced with a Show and Shine car display at the Buronga Wetlands. Entrants mingled and chatted with others while the public had the chance to view the vehicles. Entrants were asked to complete a judging form. The Rally was officially opened by the Mayor of Wentworth, Daniel Linklater. Daniel gave a great welcoming speech, wandered around the vehicles and also judged the best dressed entrants.

After lunch there was a short drive to the Sunraysia Early Settlers Museum in the old Coomealla Packers Building. Thanks to the Men In A Shed members who started the five cylinder stationary motor that is stored at the back of the building. After that entrants continued the observation run, finishing at Cowanna Almonds for afternoon tea and a very informative talk by owner, Neale Bennett.

The evening meal was held at the Club rooms. Graeme Skinner conducted the drawing of the raffle, to the delight of the many entrants who won a prize. Thanks to Ray Rowley for his effort in selling raffle tickets during Friday and Saturday.
















Minutes of the Mildura Vintage Vehicles Club Inc. Meeting 4th April 2025 at the Club Rooms

Hard copy photos required of your car:

Front view

Rear view

Drivers position (Side on view with door open)

Passenger side

Drivers side

Body and Engine numbers, stampings and plates or VIN number

Present this information to the permit scheme officers, they will do the appropriate paperwork for Vicroads.

Also remember to keep your old logbooks for 12 months.
