After that Federation still have a contract to hire the show grounds for 2027 so we will need to run the Swap that year at least. The contract also allows Federation a further 5 years after that. - passenger side - driver side - body and engine number stampings and plates Permit registration renewals are to be signed by club signatories at <u>club meetings only</u>. Please do not approach them at their workplace or home, except in a pre-arranged emergency situation.
