

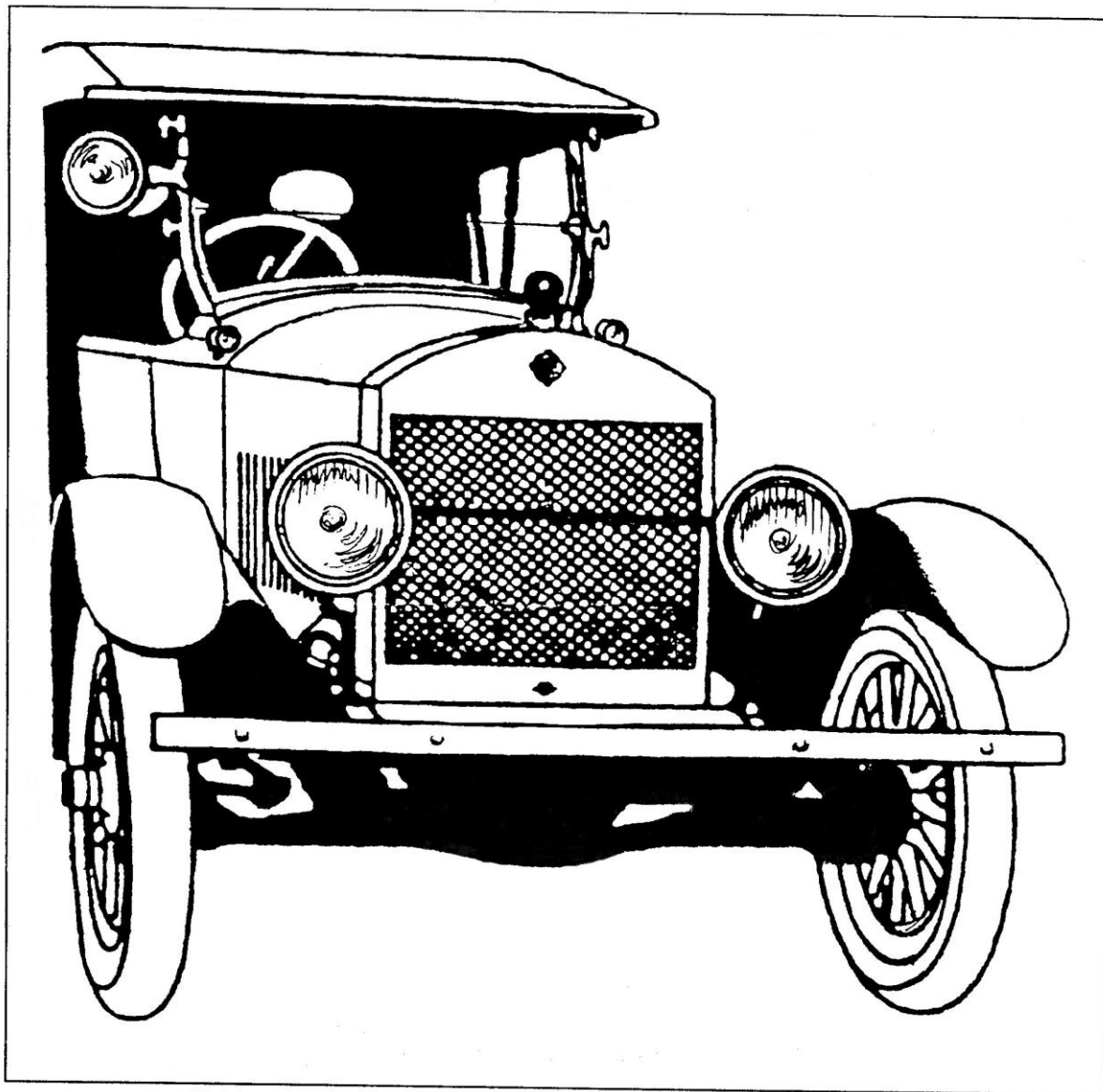

I was so worried the mechanic would rip me off because I confessed I knew nothing about cars...Imagine my relief when he said I only needed indicator fluid.

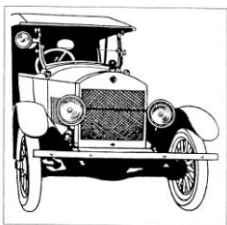
BREAKING NEWS!
