





COROWA AND DISTRICT CAR CLUB - CLUB RUNS AROUND OUR REGION

WE ARE THE PROUD OWNERS OF SOME HISTORIC OLD VEHICLES AND TO SHOW THESE VEHICLES TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, THE FOLLOWING CLUB EVENT RUNS HAVE BEEN CREATED FOR THIS TO HAPPEN AROUND OUR REGION.

** Note NSW Permit holders: These runs are scheduled on the dates indicated in the club calendar. If you wish to take one of these runs on any other day you must notify and get authority from the Club Secretary (Norm Wales) beforehand.

(This is not relevant if you are registered using the new logbook scheme)

<u>DRIVE DOWN MEMORY LANE DRIVE 1</u> Corowa, leaving the town various routes may be taken to visit Mulwala then a patrol of Yarrawonga. Make your way to Katamatite, further drive on to Shepparton then drive to Cobram, drive to Tocumwal then take Newell Highway to Finley, drive to Jerilderie, then to Oaklands, then to Daysdale & return to Corowa.

<u>DRIVE DOWN MEMORY LANE DRIVE 2</u> From Corowa take the Riverina Highway towards Albury then take the Hopefield Road then turn right at Oil Tree Lagoon Road continue to Balldale. Return home through Howlong (Balldale-Howlong Road and Riverina Highway). This trip can be reversed.

<u>DRIVE DOWN MEMORY LANE DRIVE 3</u> Corowa, drive across to Rutherglen, then to Springhurst, Chiltern & then to Wangaratta, then Hume Highway to Wodonga, across to Albury, then Hume Highway to Holbrook. Drive to Culcairn, then to Walbundrie, travel to Howlong, then Riverina Highway to Corowa.

<u>DRIVE DOWN MEMORY LANE DRIVE 4</u> Corowa, drive Riverina Highway to Howlong across to the Murray Valley Highway onto Wodonga, then to Albury, then Urana Road to Jindera, Burrumbuttock, drive to Walbundrie, drive to Rand & return to Corowa

<u>DRIVE DOWN MEMORY LANE DRIVE 5</u> Corowa, take Spring Drive to Yarrawonga, then Murray Valley Highway to Wodonga, cross to Albury then Riverina Highway to Howlong, Corowa, Savernake, down to Mulwala, then Spring Drive back to Corowa.

<u>DRIVE DOWN MEMORY LANE DRIVE 6</u> Corowa to Wahgunyah to Chiltern to Wangaratta, Myrtleford, Yackandandah, Bright, Beechworth, Albury/Wodonga, Barnawartha, Rutherglen.
