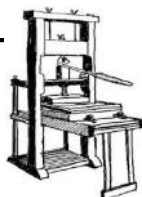

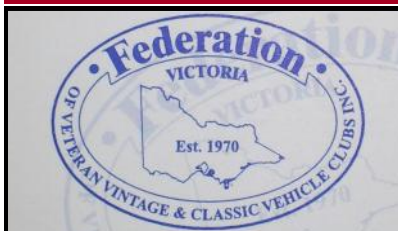

Warrnambool Weekend

On the 29th - 31st August, we travelled to Warrnambool in the Oldsmobile Toronado on what was to be one of the worst weather weekends this year. The forecast was for severe storms, and many alerts were broadcast. We attended a car club function and although about 40 people attended we were the only ones game to drive a classic car.

One of the event highlights was a visit to the Dean Montgomery private collection housed in the old Fletcher Jones factory. The collection spans two storeys and features veteran, vintage, classic, speedway, rally and race cars, motorbikes and steam traction engines. One stand out was a 1909 Renault once owned by Dame Nellie Melba. Dame Nellie ordered the car directly from Louis Renault in Paris in 1908. It is a huge car in beautiful condition.

Another featured vehicle was a 1956 Porsche 356 Speedster delivered to Norman Hamilton, in Australia, with a reutter body. During its life, the car featured prominently in motor racing.

Many other cars are displayed including Rolls Royces, Bentleys, Vauxhalls, a 888 Racing car, and Australian muscle cars including GT Falcons, Chargers and Pacers. There was also Commodore and an FJ Holden Repco Reliability around Australia Rally cars.

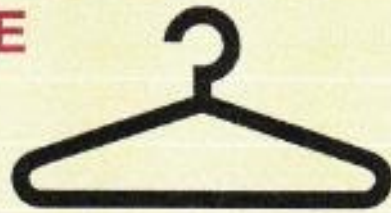

Members with vehicles on the Club Permit Scheme must remember to produce their vehicle log book (for the previous year) to the Club Permit Officer / Registrar when requesting club verification for the following permit period.
If the log book is not produced, the permit renewal will not be signed!

New Vehicles for VIC club permit scheme.

All vehicles must have a certificate of roadworthiness plus photos for club records as Vicroads may request to see them.

Hard copy photos required of your car:

Front view

Rear view

Drivers position (Side on view with door open)

Passenger side

Drivers side

Body and Engine numbers, stampings and plates or VIN number

Present this information to the permit scheme officers, they will do the appropriate paperwork for Vicroads.

Also remember to keep your old logbooks for 12 months.


