Secretaries Report : Secretary Neville Thomas reported that all Secretary correspondence had been tabled at General Meetings and he had nothing further to add.

Treasurers Report : Treasurer Dean Robertson presented a detailed report on our Clubs current financial situation. Alan Cannane moved that his report be received. Peter Anthony seconded the motion. - carried

Presidents Report : Outgoing President Neil Smith presented the following report :-

During my period as President there should have been three AGM's. I should have had two previous attempts to practise writing an annual Presidents' report.

Due to three years of Covid pandemic, this is our first real AGM in three years, and it will be my first and last annual report. We'll see how it goes. There won't be another to refine what I have done.

Club functions disappeared with lockdowns as we all hunkered down and locked up in an attempt to reduce the spread of the virus. Despite this, our membership remains strong with 180 members and we support club permits for over 400 vehicles. The permit scheme contributes to this strength, but we do have several members without permit vehicles who just enjoy belonging to a club.

Our home base at Dooen is working well. We have a good working relationship with the Hall Committee of Management. They are happy to have us on board helping to improve the hall and contributing to its upkeep. The win for us is that the arrangement gives us a very economical home base.

We have used some of our money and some grant money to develop the hall. Projects completed in the last few years include the carpeting of the building and foyer. Solar panel and a battery came from DELWP which has the potential to slash our power bills. We have new external doors all round and a new fridge in the kitchen.

A sincere thank you to retiring office bearers and to their replacements for stepping up to take a turn at contributing to the running of our club.

During lockdowns the thing that went missing was contact with others, the disappearance of our social networks. People contact is essential – it becomes a lonely life without. People develop social networks, through sports clubs, service clubs, Mens Sheds etc, and I feel this is important.

Social activity is one of the valuable offerings of our club. Vehicles may be mentioned, but value lies in the community of our club. We may have cars where you must start the engine running backwards to get a reverse gear, through to Rolls Royces, Ferraris and Model T Fords, but human contact is most important. My wife just tolerates my car habit, but happily comes along to club events because she knows there will always be great people there to mix with and have an enjoyable time. After a general meeting as it gets late, I have been known to turn a light off to give members a hint that its time to go home as they settle into serious socialising after supper. This is a terrific strength of our club and is to be nurtured.

I'll close by wishing the new executive all the best with their involvement with our club.


