"M" Plates John (Goddard) has had discussion with Federation on this subject, and he shared his discussion with members, also Peter Ninnis, Debbie Green, Alan Bail (Dec) Daryl Pendlebury and Phil Segat discussed their opinions on the implementation of the "M" Plate system. John handed the meeting over to Alan Bail and Daryl Pendlebury for a secret ballot form the members. Result Yes 53 No 27 total votes counted 80. The committee will attend to the implementation of "m" Plate system with VicRoads.

28/9/2015

Modifieds Vehicle Criteria - FOR DISCUSSION AT OCTOBER MEETING

Club members have voted on and accepted modified Vehicles into the Club. Some vehicles already in our club on historic permit will now be able to transfer to "M" permit and be used legally with our Club, Proposed guidelines have been circulated within the Club with minimal dispute arising.

In 2011 Daryl Pendlebury made a motion for the AGM with the following summary. The vehicle owner to prove suitability via sales, trade or service literature and or contemporary motoring press of any disputed modifications, final decision on acceptability will be made by Committee, Permit Officers and/or Subcommittee formed to deal with modified vehicles following are guidelines for modifications acceptable to our Club. The emphasis is on Classic Street machines - NOT HOTRODS.

Also, these vehicles must be proven Roadworthy by R.W.C and VASS if applicable, any factory options are acceptable, in some sections I have included examples for clarification.





The next breakfast will be at the Lake Boga Café. Just get yourself there, no ride organised ,bur will think of something over breakfast.



Hand it into the permit officer who will sign and stamp it to have ready to collect at the end of the meeting. Mail your Club Permit renewal along with your signed and completed safety check sheet. Please ensure that you include a stamped self-addressed envelope so that the renewal an be returned to you straight away. **DO NOT SEND** your Club Permit book or money. Payments are to be made by the owner at Vic Roads

Always ensure that there is a completed safety check form for each renewal. These forms are available on our website under members section, www.shvcvc.com.au or in our Manifold. The club's Post Office box is cleared every day, and the renewals are returned in the post the next day.

Remember that if your renewal is overdue Vic Roads will not re-register your vehicle and you will have to complete a roadworthy to re-register your vehicle. So when you get your renewal get it proceeded straight away and then you have it ready to pay the renewal when its due.
