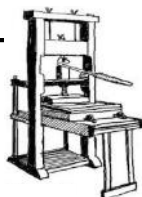

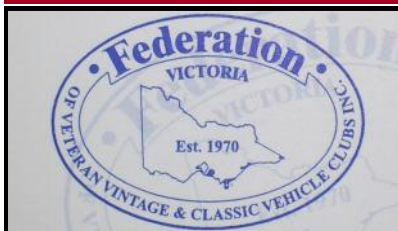

Do you buy online?

I do on occasions and this is my story from the other day. We bought a Diesel Territory recently and it was due for oil and oil filter change, new air cleaner element and a fuel filter as well. I bought the oil, air and oil filter locally as they were on special and I wanted them straight away as there was a chance I could do the change in the next day or two. I bought the fuel filter off E-Bay for one third the price of a local shop. The oil change and air cleaner change went no without any problem. The fuel filter needs four lines disconnecting, the filter and its mounting bracket removed from the car (after disconnecting the sensor from the bottom of it) so the mount and sensor can be swapped to the new filter.



This photo shows the old filter on the right and the new one on the left. All looks OK doesn't it!

When I put the filter back into its correct mount and plugged the hoses back onto the top, the last hose one would not connect as its retaining clip fouled the clip from the next pipe over.

Hmmmm



After a little bit of cursing (Yes not too much) I removed it again and compared the old with the new. When I sat them end to end and compared the spacing of the pipes, you can see from the photo (left) that upper pipe is about 7mm closer to its neighbour compared to the original spacings. That 7mm was enough to stop the last pipe clicking on. I got a refund OK and they didn't want the dodgy one back. A quick run back into town 10 min before closing time and had to pay the normal price for one that fitted no worries! Would I buy off E-Bay again, probably as long as I wasn't in a hurry but I still like buying local as a you usually walk out with the goods without having to wait for a week.

New Vehicles for VIC club permit scheme.

All vehicles must have a certificate of roadworthiness plus photos for club records as Vicroads may request to see them.

Hard copy photos required of your car:

Front view

Rear view

Drivers position (Side on view with door open)

Passenger side

Drivers side

Body and Engine numbers, stampings and plates or VIN number

Present this information to the permit scheme officers, they will do the appropriate paperwork for Vicroads.

Also remember to keep your old logbooks for 12 months.

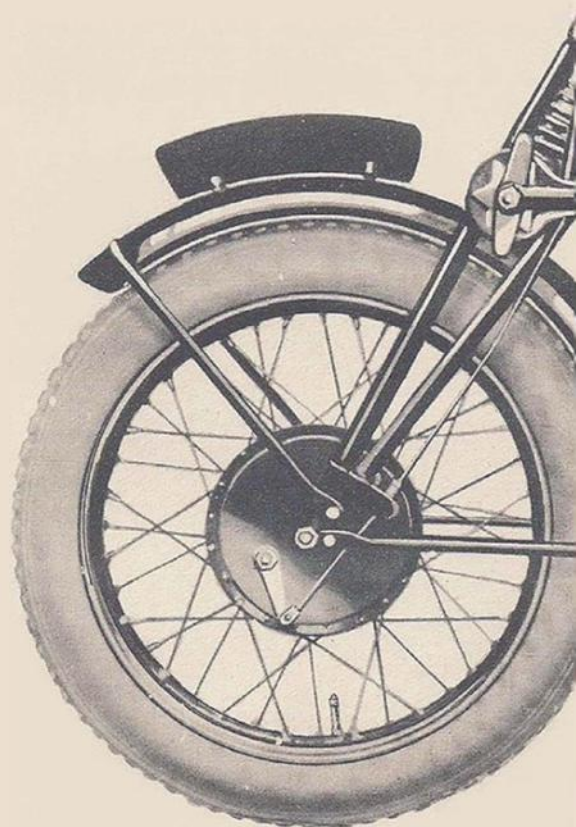

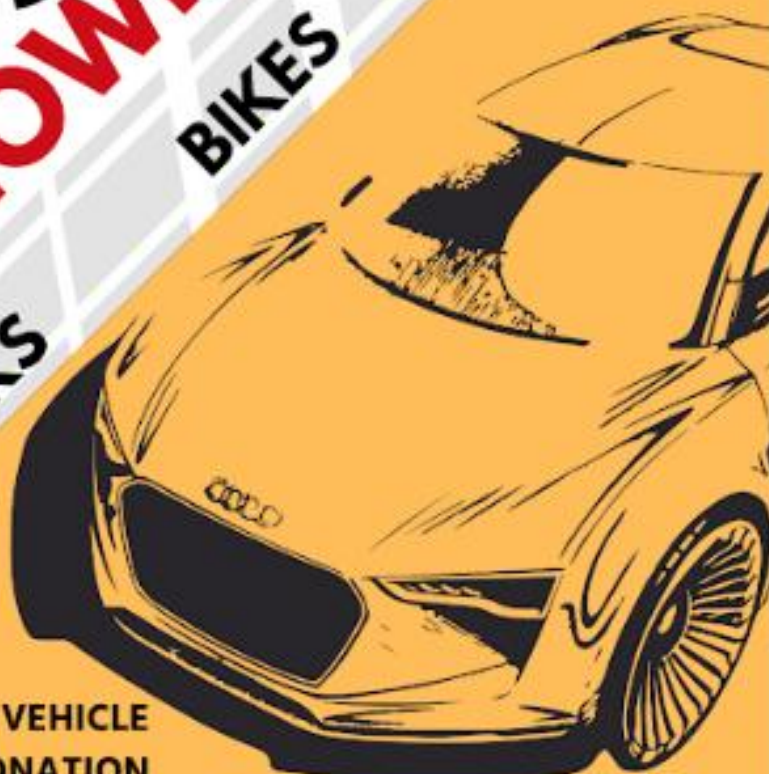

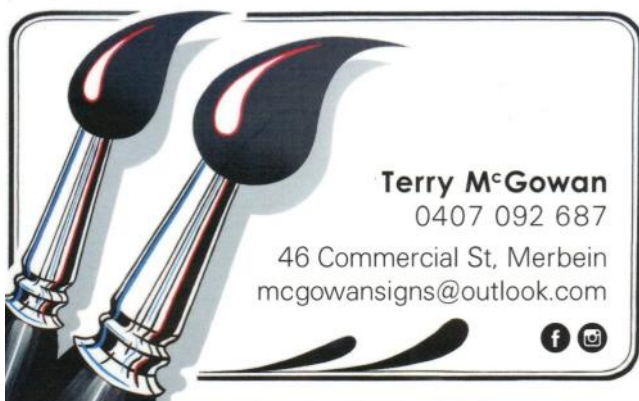
