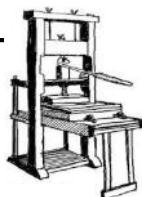

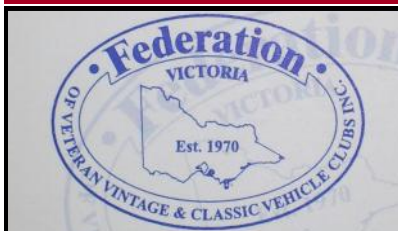

THE MG MUSUEM OF THE MARQUE

We recently visited the MG Museum of the Marque, a collection of over forty MG badged vehicles spanning from 1914 to 2005. It's located in Belmont, Geelong and owned by Ray and John Abikhair. The history of the MG cars was very interesting, particularly the pre-war vehicles which were quite stunning. The museum is run by volunteers who give a full history of each vehicle during their tour. Self-serve tea, coffee and biscuits are included in the entry fee, fifty percent of which is donated to charity. Gerry and Karen.

Left: 1930 MG 18/80 is a very rare car imported from the Netherlands in 2016. It is a 2.5lt, 6cyl producing 80hp and could reach 80mph, which was impressive at the time



Left: 1934 MG PA Airline chassis no. 0286 was the first airline body produced for an MG. This particular car was a prototype and was retained as a demonstrator. Of the 289 cars produced, only twelve are known to exist worldwide with two of them being in this museum.

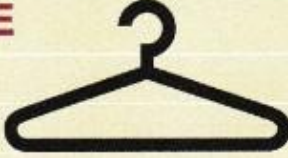
The Photographic history of our club will continue to evolve over time and will be on display at club functions and gatherings where and when convenient.

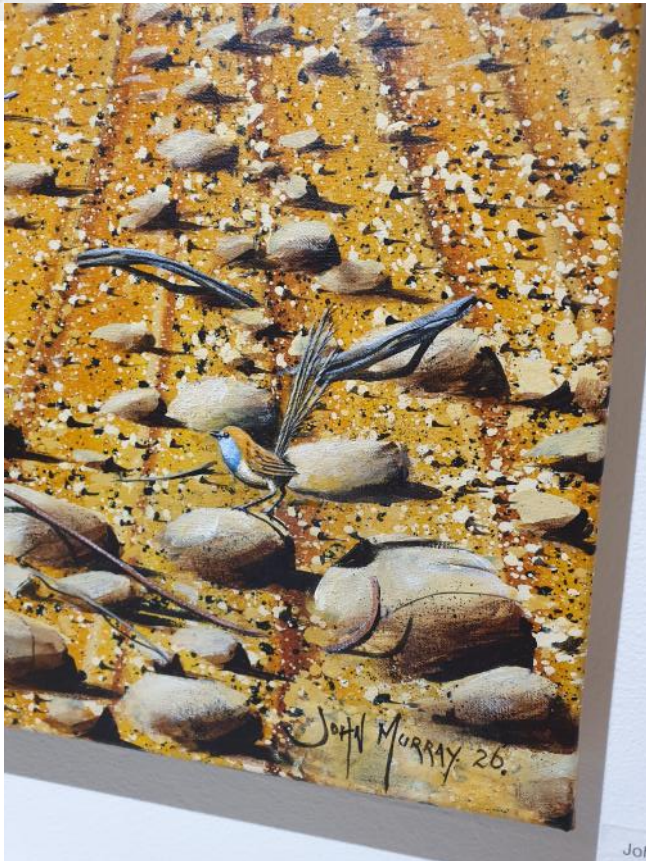

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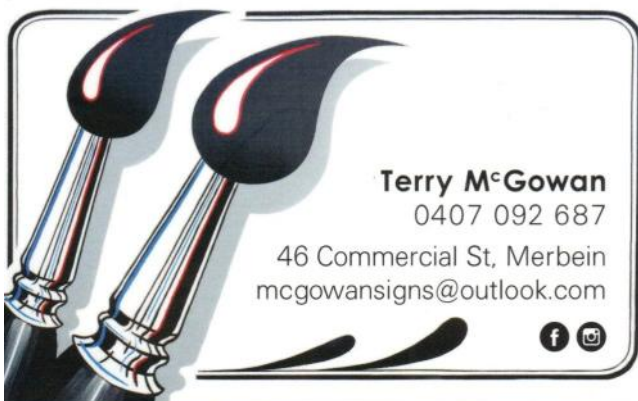


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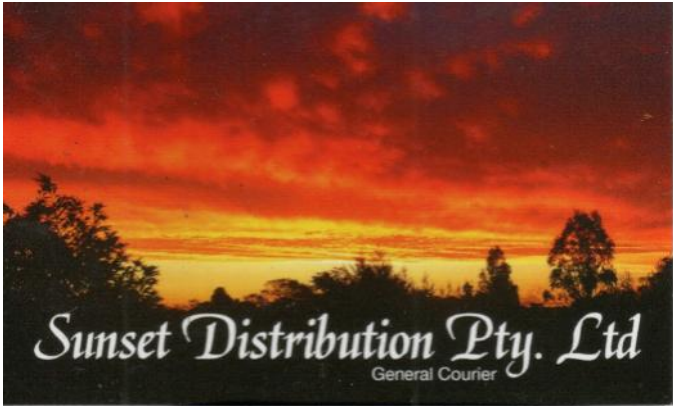
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
