Our recent 'Mystery Run' was to a local business 'Aeropaint Australia'. Keith Kirby gave an excellent presentation of his business involving the renovation and restoration of Classic Aircraft.  
We also had good numbers attend Dadswells Town lunch.

Swap Meet : Terry Pollock announced that after protracted negotiation, the Swap Committee and Club Executive have agreed to cease our agreement with the Horsham Agricultural Society, ending a 40 plus year relationship. The area we have occupied is undergoing development which was becoming restrictive and costs continued to increase.

A 'new' site has been negotiated on the main Showgrounds east of Robinson Street. The site – whilst still at the Horsham Showgrounds proper offers more room, a greater visual impact from passing traffic and significantly less cost.

The site has been carefully measured, scaled and enough area for 250 sites with room to expand. A meeting with the Rotary Club re catering has been carried out and a site agreed to, to provide eats and drinks.

Terry reminded members that we will be looking for a greater volunteer effort from our members as we negotiate the change. The Swap is our major fund raiser.

Annual Tour : Bruce Brody reported that entry forms are now available for our Annual Combined Clubs Tour in October. Club Members are informed that 'tag along' is perfectly OK if you cannot participate in the full weekend.

Insurance : Colin Kemp reported on the recently introduced AOMC Public Liability Insurance. Pricing looks attractive, but we will have to look closely at issues such as an increase in risk management procedures. Where we might need to be more hands on. Certainly worth looking into.

General Business : Terry Pollock moved a motion that the WMHVS look into and purchase two (2) ‘teardrop’ banners, complete with Club logo, to be used in conjunction with Club static displays, Swap Meet etc. Seconded by Neville Thomas - carried

Neville Thomas reported that although the Motoring Heritage Day was a great day for those members that took part. In effect less than 25% of our members turned out on what was a perfect opportunity to take part. He reminded members that our Historic Permit Scheme in Victoria, one of the best in Australia, should be treated as a privilege. The current scheme which has been operating since 2011, was only achieved after years of protracted negotiation between VicRoads, and our peak bodies, AOMC and the Federation. We will look to make this an Annual event.

Neville also brought to the meetings attention, that all too often, when we are organizing catering for an event and need numbers, too many members are ignoring the cut off date we publish, and think its OK to ring at the last minute or simply turn up. Or commit, then don’t take part. This attitude puts immense pressure on those who are organizing this type of event, and simply shows a lack of respect. We need to improve and get the message out. Please take note of cut off dates in future.

Thankyou Helen for your great efforts in wrangling the final list of who turned up and those that didn't.

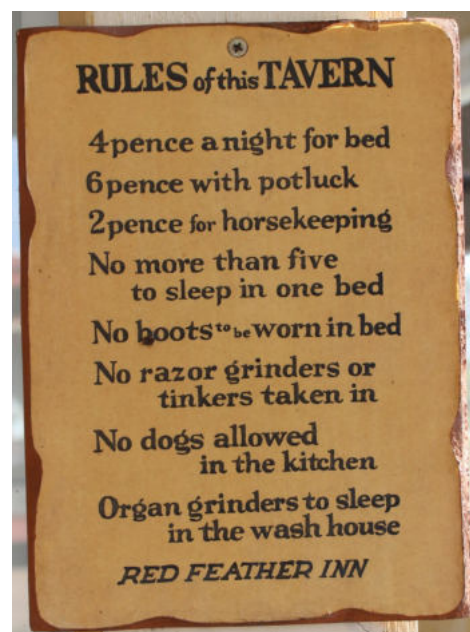
