



Federation Delegates Meeting & AGM 5th August 2023 Meeting held in Werribee at the Masonic Hall hosted by the Hobsons Bay Mens Shed Motoring Group. Capital Grants for the purchase of Plant & Equipment for two clubs was approved a further application was held over until the required application forms are lodged. Peter Mac fund raising has reached \$5,000.00. President Neil Athorn thanked all clubs who joined in the combined fund raising for their commitment in the project.

Picnics planned for next year are underway, Mortlake on the 24th March 2024 will celebrate 20 years, an application to Moira Council has been made for funding to increase the entertainment and prizes on the day The Wunghnu Picnic will be held over the Easter Weekend in March 2024, Murrabit Picnic on the 19th May 2024 celebrating National Motoring Heritage Day, Baw Baw Picnic will be held on the 24th October 2024. Bendigo to Castlemaine run to held on the 26th August 2023, members can book to have breakfast on that day at the Bendigo Clubrooms from 8am at \$5.00 per person, bookings to Neil Athorn. Marong Picnic 27th August 2023. Members are asked to show club newsletter which has advertised the picnic day at the gate to gain free entry into the picnic. Free raffle entry for all club members who attend. Murrabit Picnic, flyers we're handed out at the Delegates Meeting interest was received from a couple of Clubs as to including the event in a club weekend away.

The Bendigo Swap is on track with all outdoor sites booked, three sites in the REC Centre are available, volunteer numbers are down, there has been a second call for clubs to ask members to revisit their availability to volunteer over the weekend. Clubs are paid \$10. per hour for every hour members work, free entry into the swap for day worked and a \$10. Refreshment allowance for volunteers is provided. The Federation AGM was held after the meeting with all Committee Members returned to same positions for the 2023 to 2024 year Brett Holloway Federation Treasurer reported that although Federation hadn't received any income from the Bendigo Swap for 3 years he has been able to maintain a reasonable balance without increasing club's Membership fees for the coming year.
